HIGH SCHOOL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

St. Elizabeth offers a year-round volunteer program for high school students.

For training and scheduling purposes, the program is divided into

3 onboarding sessions annually.

- Students accepted into the program may continue throughout the year with priority scheduling/placements OR they may leave the program and return during the next onboarding window with priority scheduling/placements prior to new volunteer enrollment.
- Verification of hours will not be provided until the student has completed a successful session
 - Example: Volunteers entering the program in Mid-May must volunteer through mid-August, at minimum.
 - Completion of a successful session is defined as a session without excessive absences.

PROGRAM SESSIONS

Session 1

- Priority enrollment/scheduling month for current/returning volunteers: December
- Applications open 1st Tuesday in January at 3pm
- Session runs January through May

Session 2

- Priority enrollment/scheduling month for current/returning volunteers: April
- Applications open 3rd Monday in April at 3pm
- Session runs June through mid-August

Session 3

- Priority enrollment/scheduling month for current/returning volunteers: July
- Applications open 1st Monday in August at 3pm
- Session runs mid-August through December



COMMITMENT EXPECTATIONS

Volunteers are asked to commit to each session through enrollment/re-enrollment.

Volunteer Schedule

- Minimum of one 3-4 hour shift
- Average 1 shift per week
- Regularly scheduled (same schedule each week)*

*Volunteer Services staff work individually with each high school volunteer to determine a best schedule during each session

PROCESS TO BECOME A HIGH SCHOOL VOLUNTEER

1. Complete an Online Volunteer Application, once available at the start of each onboarding session.

- 2. Have a Recommendation Form completed by a teacher, school counselor, or school administrator (non-family members).
- 3. Attend an Applicant Information Session (Date must be selected on online application).

All prospective High School Volunteers must attend an in-person Information Session prior to acceptance into the program.

Once accepted into the program, volunteers will be invited to schedule and attend an individual volunteer placement appointment.

Accepted volunteers must complete a required orientation packet including forms, hospital orientation and health requirements, and attend applicable training.

NEW VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

All Volunteers are required to complete an onboarding process that mirrors new St. Elizabeth Associates.
